 - Bonnie reported we have one candidate for Governor Elect and appointments or elections for all Lt Governors except Zone 6

- **Essay and Oratorical** Gabrielle VanHooydonk

District essay contest, with Camille Bessner from Cornwall winning first place and a \$2,500 bursary, followed by Lana Caramé from Aurora in second place with a \$1,500 bursary, and Aiden Joyce from Main Place in third place with a \$1,000 bursary

- **CCDHH** Past Governor Ted Simmonds

Increase in participation with 25 students involved and 6-7 signers this year

- **Junior Golf** Dennis Kwasnicki
